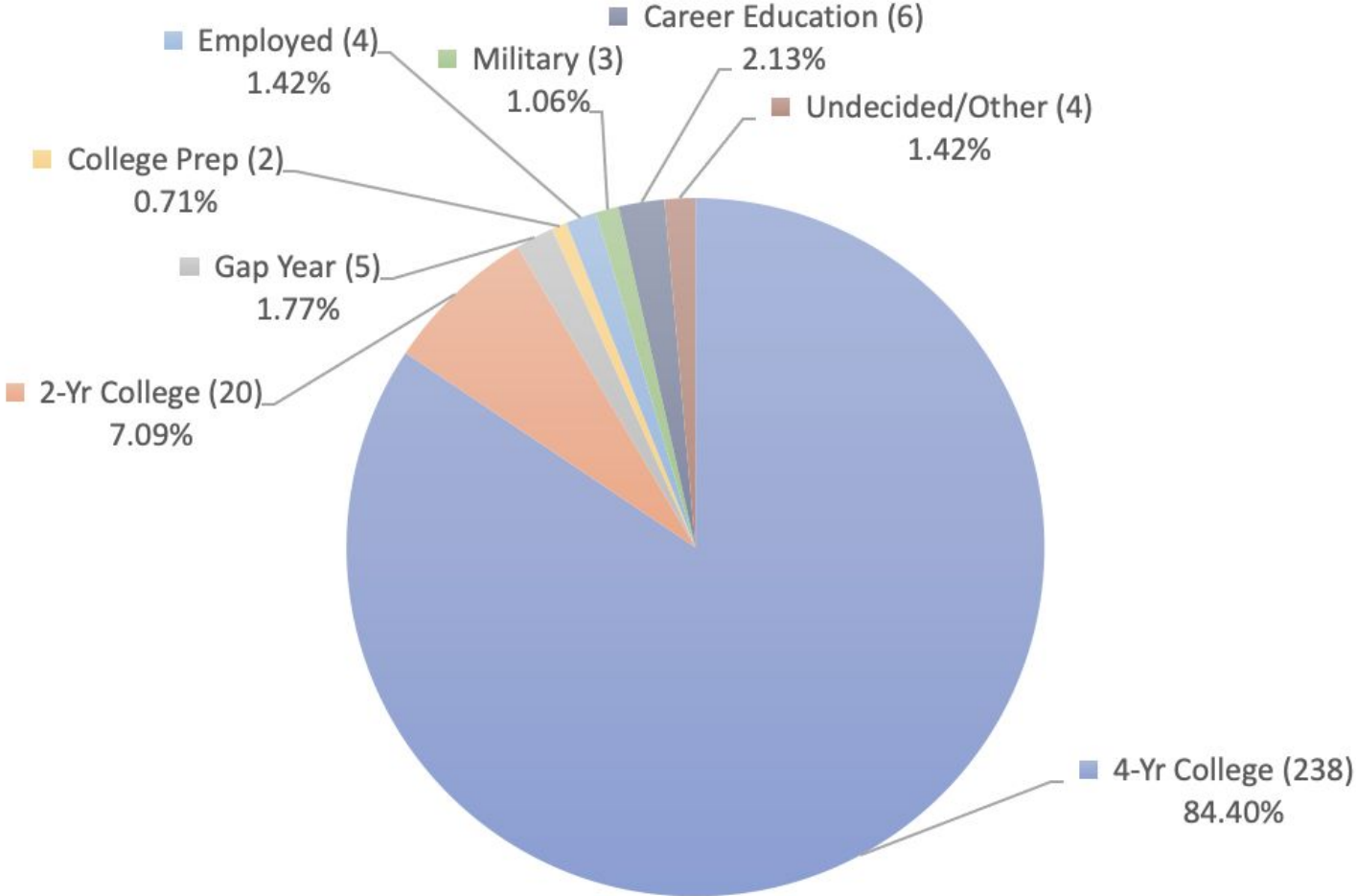

Early Decision

- 103 ED applications (including 20 EDII)
 - 9 students applied both EDI & EDII
- 94 students applied EDI and/or EDII
 - 36% of college-going cohort applied ED
- 64 acceptances ED overall
 - 62.1% admit rate ED
- ED continues to play a role in maximizing admissions chances at many schools

First Generation College Students

- $n = 50$ (17.7% of class; self-reported)
 - 78% (39) students submitted at least one application
- 295 applications (220 acceptances)
- 76% pursuing higher education

Low-Income Students

- receive Free or Reduced lunch
- n = 44 (15.6% of class)*
- 232 applications (168 acceptances)
- 2- and 4-year college-going rate = 72.7%

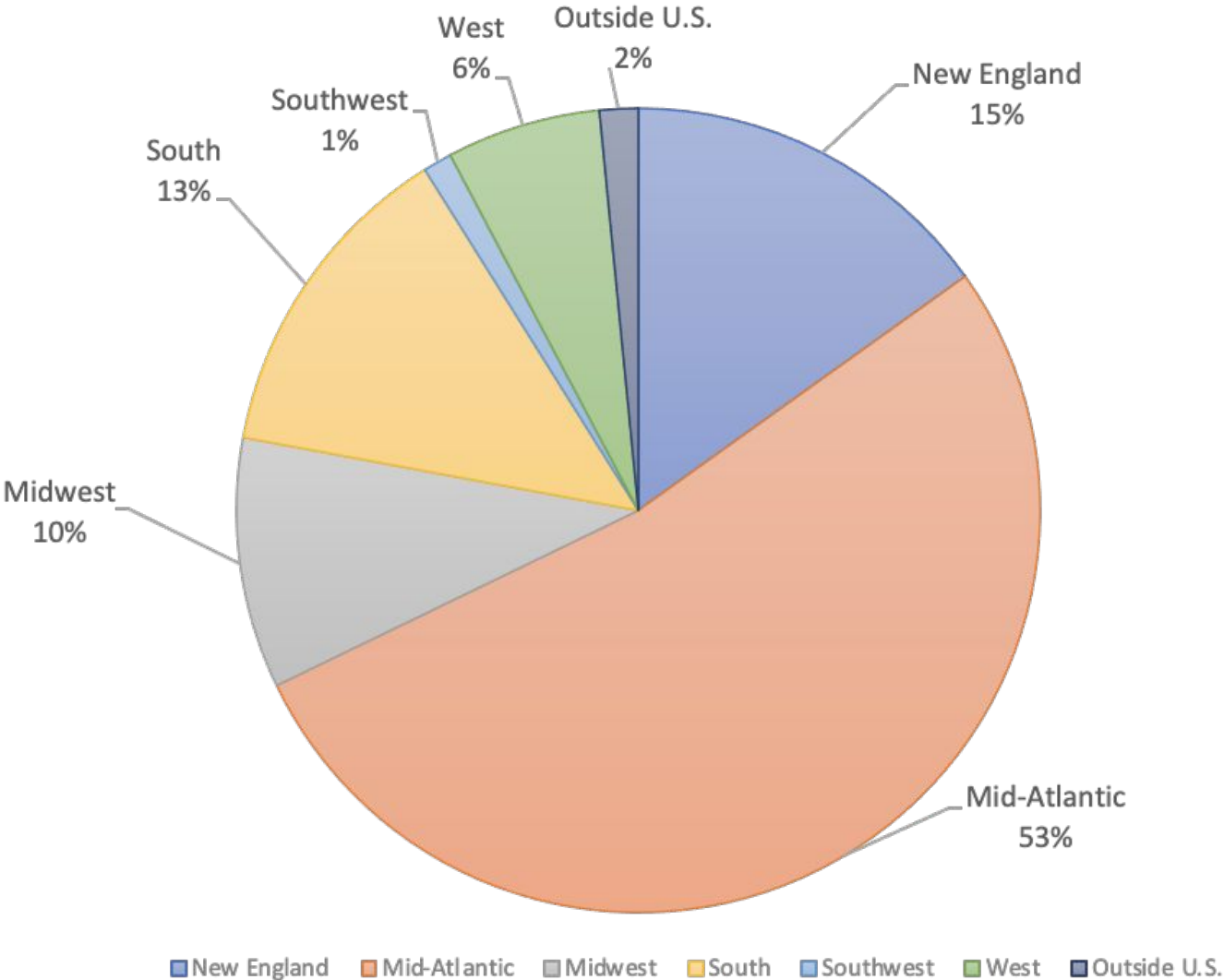
