

Early Decision

- 95 ED applications (including 14 EDII)
 - 8 students applied both EDI & EDII
- □ 35.4% of college-going cohort applied ED
- □ 51 ED acceptances overall \rightarrow 53.7% admit rate ED
- ED continues to play a role in maximizing admissions chances at many schools but it is a *personal*, *family decision*

First Generation College Students

- □ Defined as: "students whose parents have not earned a 4-year degree"
- \square n = 46 (16% of class; self-reported)
- □ 80% (37) students submitted at least one application
- □ 254 total applications (181 acceptances)
- 78.3% pursuing higher education

- \square n = 33 (11.5% of class)*
 - *Impacted by free lunch for all actual number is higher
- □ 184 applications (124 acceptances)
- \square 2- and 4-year college-going rate = 75.8%


