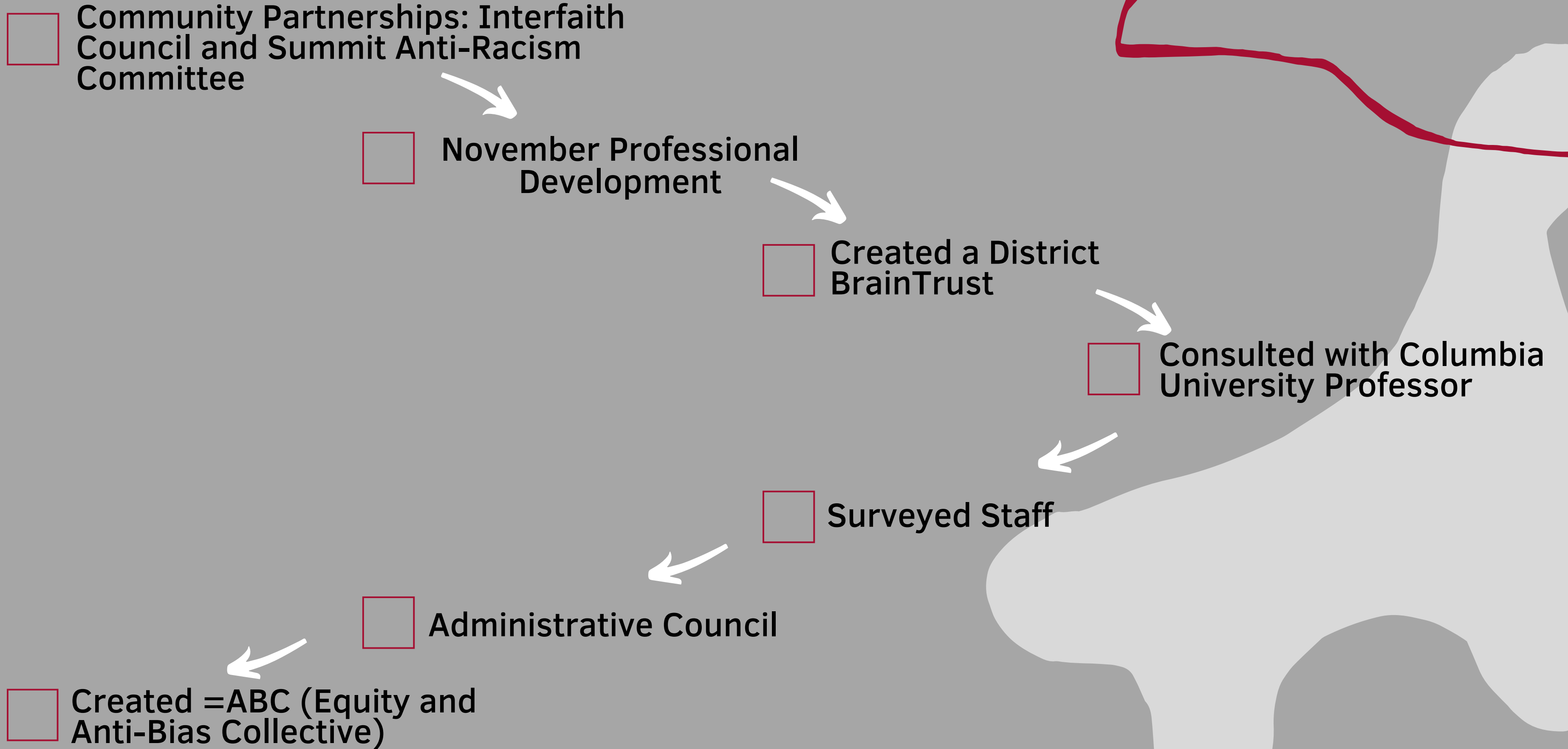
## **GOAL 2:**

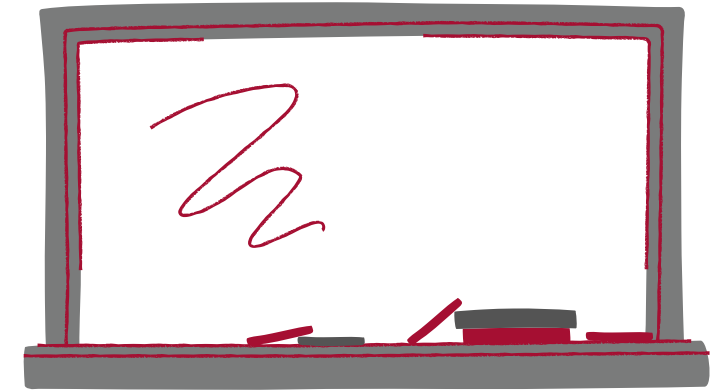

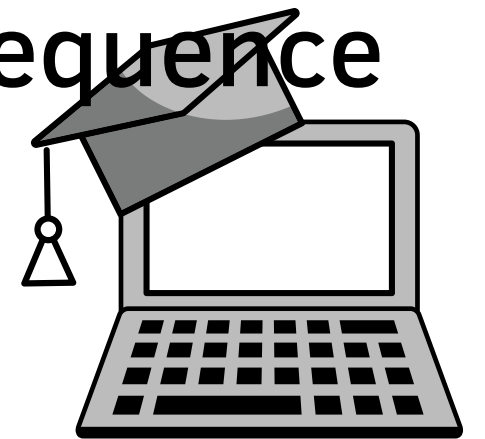

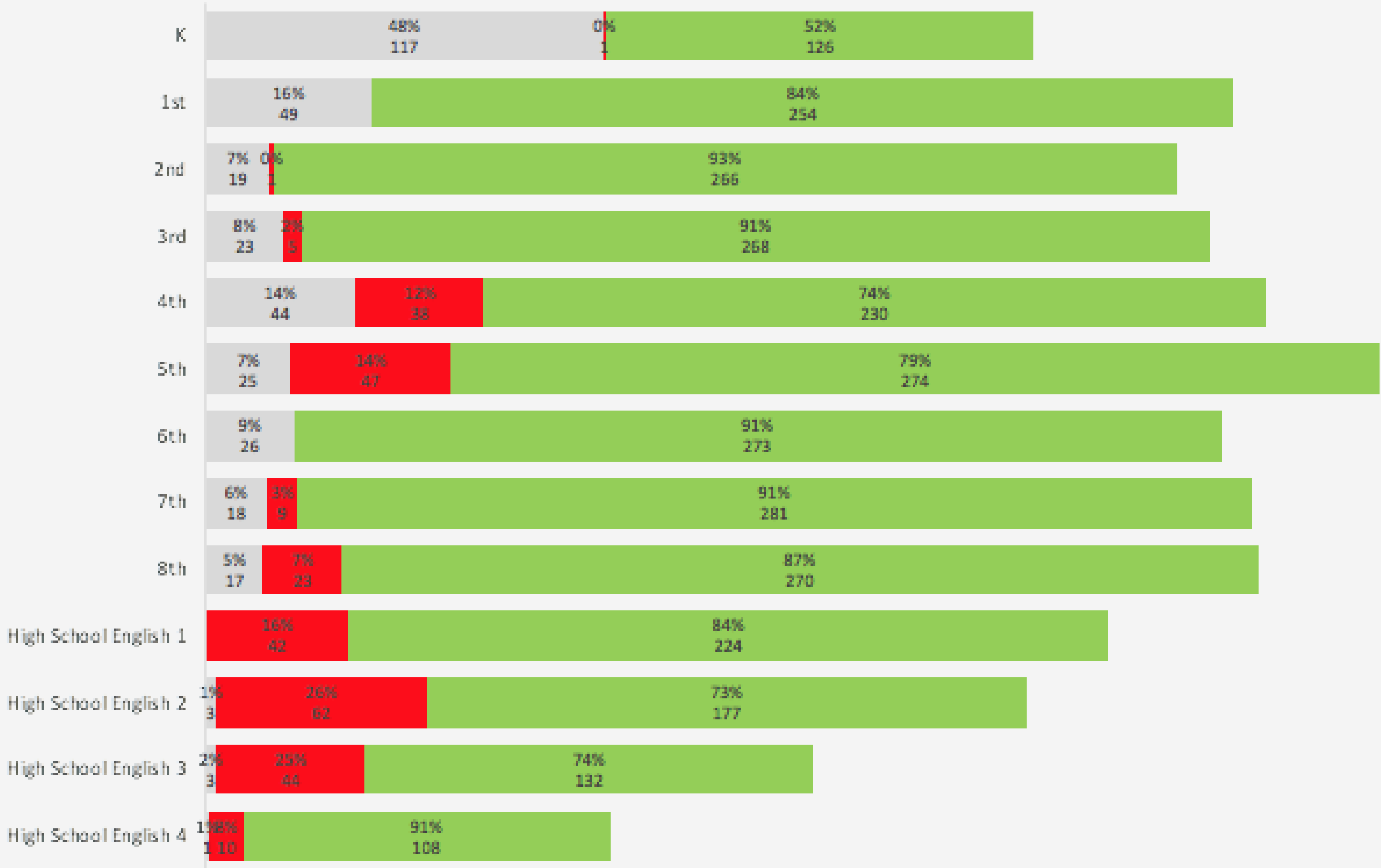
## Goal 3:

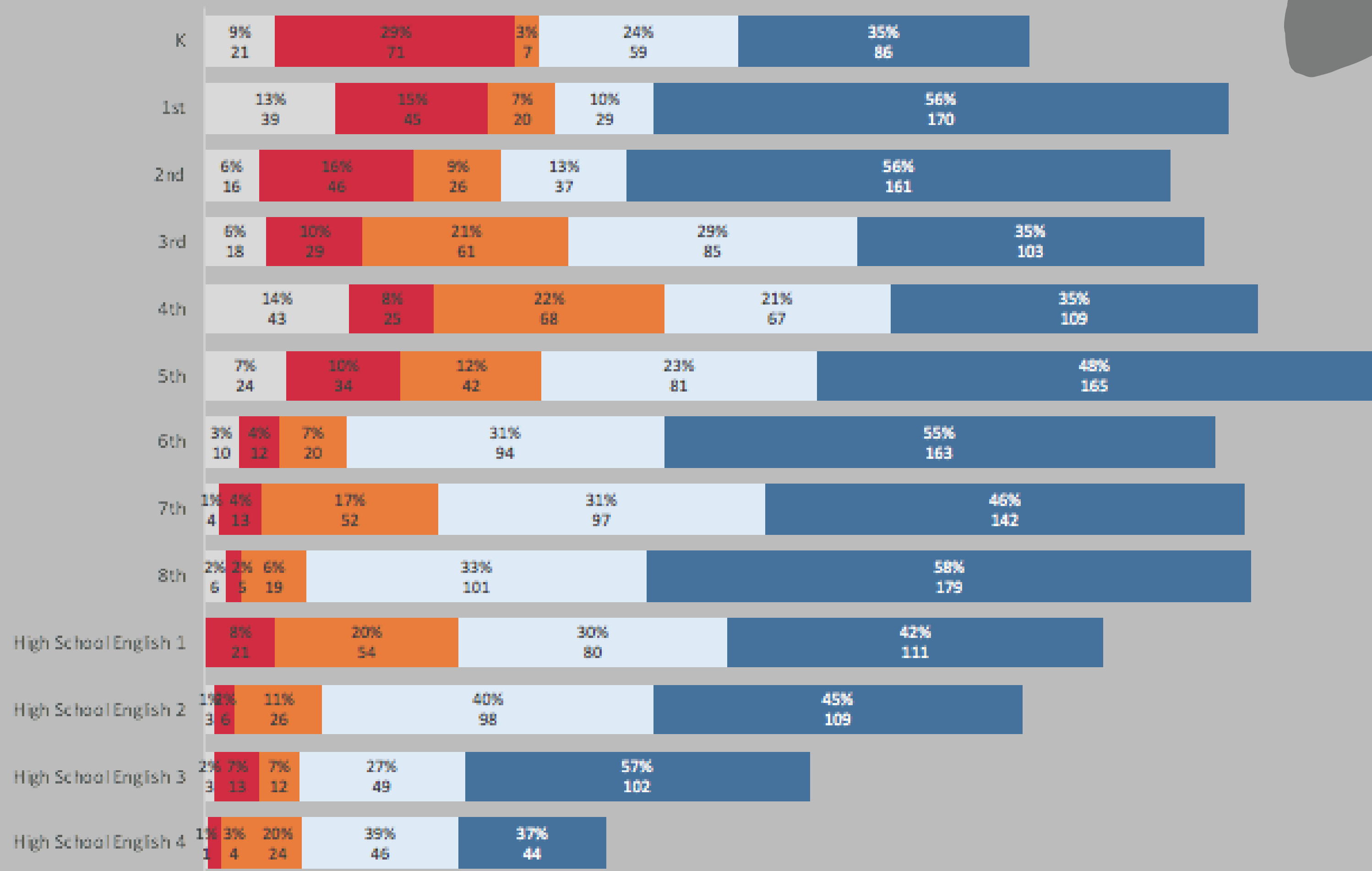
# ELA GROWTH GOAL ACHIEVED - ALL GRADES

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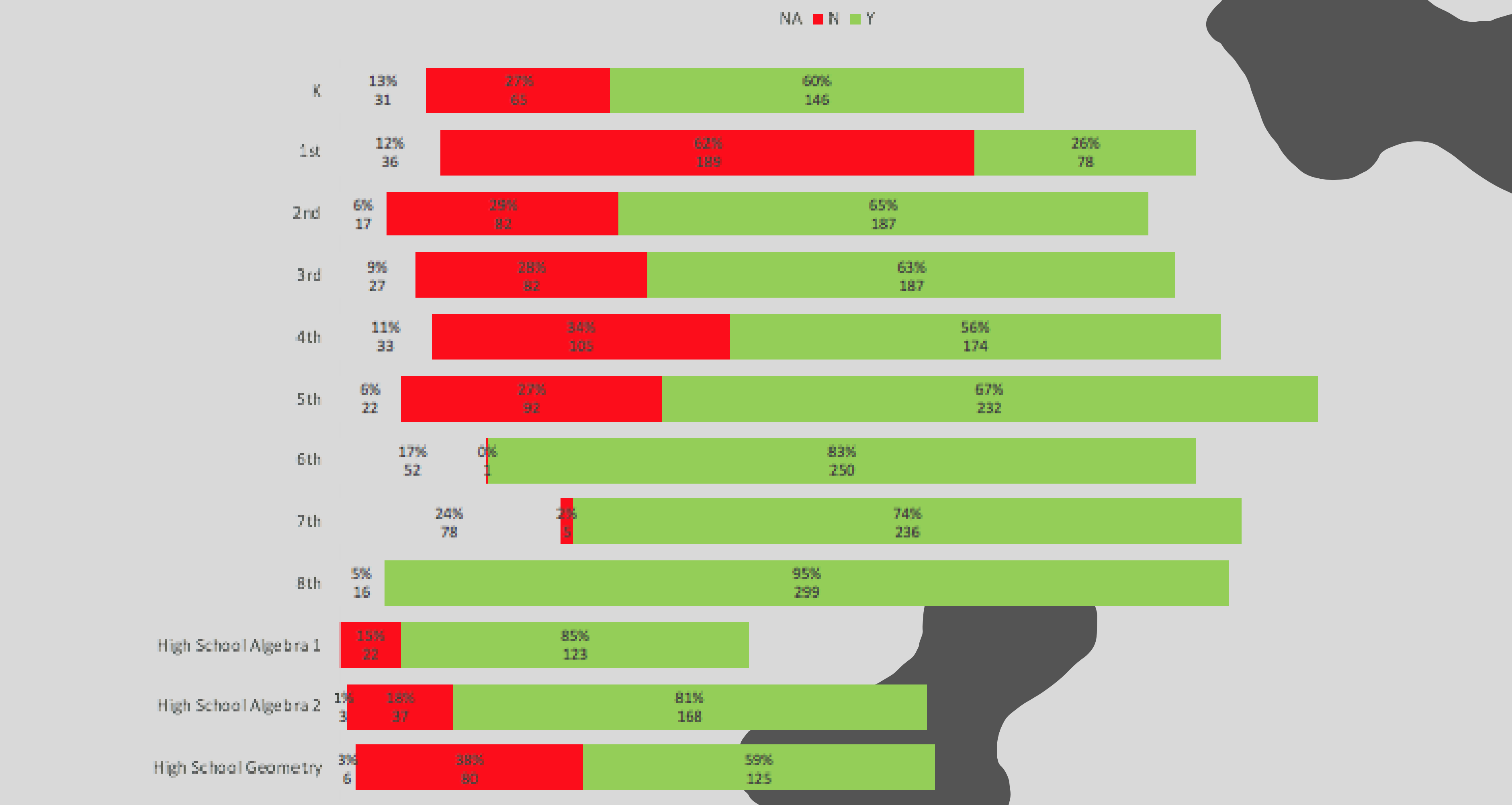


# ELA STANDARDS PROFICIENCY DISTRIBUTION - ALL GRADES

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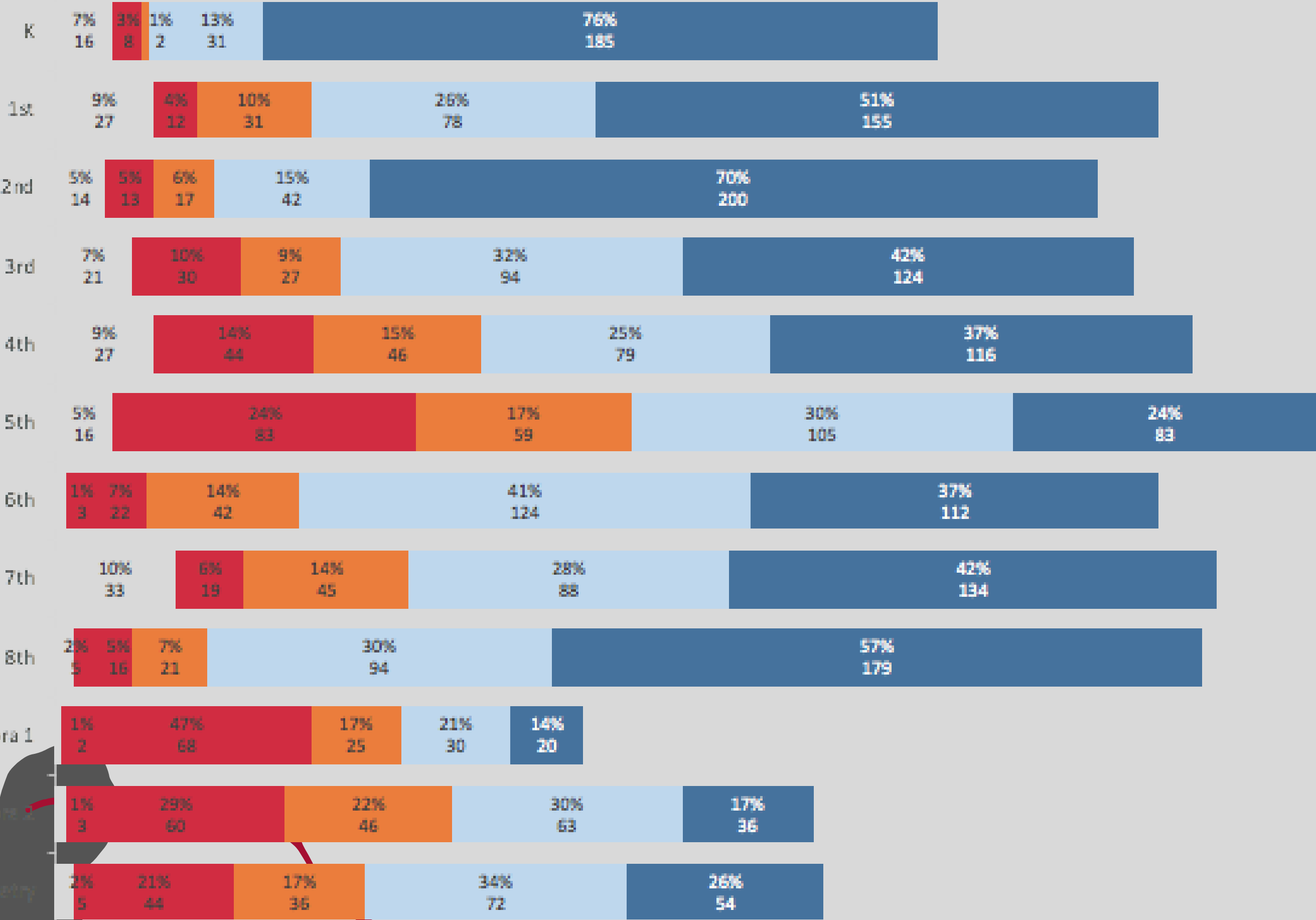


# MATH GROWTH GOAL ACHIEVED - ALL GRADES
