## SUMMIT PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Middle/High School Registration Requirements include:

1. Documentation of a physical less than 365 days old
2. A complete immunization record including:
A. (3) doses of DPT (Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Tetanus) or Td (Tetanus and Diphtheria).
If 5 years have elapsed since the last Tetanus/Tetanus Dipththeria booster, Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) is required.
B. (3) doses of (OPV or IPV) Polio Vaccine.
C. (2) doses of (MMR) Measles, Mumps and Rubella Vaccine.
C. (2) doses of (MMR) Measles, Mumps and Rubella Vaccine D. (3) doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine.

Mantoux Testing (TB Testing) is country specific. Any student transferring in from any country listed below <u>DOES NOT</u> have to be TB tested. The Tuberculosis Program of the New Jersey Department of Health provides the list of countries annually.
