 - AP Statistics

Science Electives

- *Choose 2 of the following Science Electives:*
 - Marine Biology
 - Introduction to Animal Science
 - Science Research 1 (Prerequisite for Science Research 2)
 - Science Research 2
 - Advanced Science Research

Other Electives

- *Choose 2 of the following Electives:*
 - Financial Literacy & Economics or AP Macroeconomics
 - Law
 - International Affairs
 - Journalism
 - Photography
