

Suggested Supplies for Third Grade



To help you avoid unnecessary purchases in September, the following supplies are suggested for third graders:

1½" Three Ring Binder (please do not buy "zip around" binders, it is very difficult to maneuver them in our desks!)

1 package of **Notebook Paper** (wide ruled)

2 **2-pocket folders**, with holes to fit in binder

2 **100-sheet marble composition book** (wide ruled)

12" Ruler (inches and centimeters)

Scissors

4 Glue sticks

Colored Pencils and/or Crayons

Pencil Case (One with three holes so it can fit in the three ring binder)

10-12 Pencils and erasers (Please try to sharpen pencils before school. Also, no mechanical pencils!)

1 package of **thin dry-erase board markers**

1 **manual pencil sharpener** (Small, for desk use)

***Teachers will provide **subject dividers** for the binders.

Summer Preparation for Third Grade

Know all addition and subtraction facts from 0 through 20.

Daily Reading: You should read at least three books from the suggested reading list.

After you finish reading each book, you should be able to answer the following questions:

Who is the author?

Who were the main characters?

What was the setting?

What was the big problem of the entire story?

How did the big problem get solved?
